Coaching Financial Assistance Policy & Application

Dear Applicant,

Thank you for the desire and commitment to develop your leadership. It is a joy for our District to bring support as you work toward this goal.

Enclosed, you will find the District Funding Policy for PAOC Ministerial Credential Holders taking Leadership Development through Coaching which provides the requirements, allotment amounts and process for the funding. Additionally, there is an Application for District Financial Assistance For Leadership Development through Coaching for submission to the Leadership Education and Development Committee.

Policy for receiving Financial Assistance for PAOC District Ministerial Credential Holders taking Leadership Development through Coaching

Requirements for receiving District financial assistance for leadership development through Coaching

- Applicants must hold an active or inactive Recognition of Ministry Credential, Licensed Minister Credential or Ordained Credential with the Alberta and NWT District of the PAOC.
- Coaches must have completed approved training through the International Coaching Federation (ICF). A letter of verification may be required.
- Coaching sessions receiving financial assistance must be completed in a 12 month period.

Financial Allotment

- Financial assistance will be provided for 50% of the charge of a Coaching session to a maximum of \$50.00 per session for a total of four sessions completed.
- Financial assistance may be accessed once every 3 years.
- Accessibility of financial assistance is subject to availability of funding provided in the annual District budget.

Process for Receiving Financial Assistance

- An approved application form will be required. Notice of approval will be provided by notice from the District office.
- Funds will be issued upon receipt of a copy of paid invoice from the Coach showing the number of sessions, cost per session and the total amount paid for Coaching sessions received.
